Training Structure

Session 1: Introduction to Outdoor Learning (1 Hour)

- Topics Covered:
 - Overview of the Muddy Puddle Teacher approach.
 - Benefits of outdoor learning for physical, emotional, and cognitive development.
 - Whole-school impact of embedding outdoor education.
- Interactive Activities:
 - Icebreaker: “Nature Bingo” to explore the training venue.
 - Group discussion on current outdoor practices and challenges.

Session 2: Curriculum Integration Outdoors (1.5 Hours)

- Topics Covered:
 - Linking outdoor activities to the national curriculum.
 - Subject-specific strategies for outdoor learning (math, literacy, science, art).
 - Adapting lessons for different key stages.
- Hands-On Activities:
 - Create and trial outdoor lessons in small groups using natural materials.

Lesson 1 - Rock Detectives!

Before we Start

Go outside and do the Muddy Walk & Talk. Everyone walks around a circle, clockwise. Pair up with another friend, walk side by side and discuss these questions.

- What do you already know about rocks?
- What do rocks look like?
- How do they feel?
- What do we use them for?
- What is their purpose in nature?

Intro

What is a rock? Meet our children's search for knowledge about rocks and their uses. This is a lesson plan for a 45-minute session. It includes a video, a worksheet, and a PowerPoint presentation. The lesson is designed for children aged 5-7 years.

Aims and Objectives

- To identify the different types of rocks.
- To understand the uses of rocks in nature and in everyday life.

Task 2 - Grouping

Grouping tasks are used to help children to work together and share their ideas. This task involves children working in groups to identify different types of rocks and their uses.


Exploring at Home Task

Ask your children to go outside and look for rocks. They can bring some back to school and we can look at them together. They can also draw pictures of the rocks they find.

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FAQ: Are you like Forest School?

Are you like Forest Schools?

We are NOT Forest School. We often need clarification with Forest School, but we are entirely different. Many of our schools have Forest Schools and Muddy Teachers trained and used both approaches effectively.

Forest School is holistic and encourages high risks to promote social and emotional well-being, such as tools and fire, and typically is in a woodland area with prolonged amounts of time outside, such as a full day or entire afternoon. The Muddy Puddle Teacher is an Outdoor Learning Approach, an extension of inside teaching and taking lessons outside. We typically use our school grounds, and there are no set periods to stay there, and it can be anything from 10 minutes to full days in the summer.

What is involved in The Muddy Puddle Teacher Training?

Individuals & International Schools

Individuals and schools abroad typically take the online route and complete the training using an easy-to-use online format. It is very interactive with audiobooks and demonstration videos. It has four stages, and each step takes around 2 hours. There is no written work, just a questionnaire to ensure you get the most from us. You send that once complete, and we send back a certificate and a unique MPT Code; a crest can also be requested.

Whole Schools or Nurseries

We offer 1-year mentorships to schools and nurseries. We have a 100% success rate with this method.
